Killyon Manor is steeped in over a thousand years of Irish history. Pagans, Celts, colonisers, even Vikings have been here. From eternal brides, mad priests and soldier ghosts, and hidden treasure, their tales are buried in the earth, written in the trees, hidden in the scattered ruins and sacred sites around this land.

The Ruined Chapel

The chapel ruin is one such destination on a forested island of the Manor's nature reserve, encircled by the River Deel. A natural aisle of tall, arching trees create a cathedral roof above you and lead you to this picturesque backdrop for small open-air ceremonies, immersed in history, filled with candlelight, and birdsong.

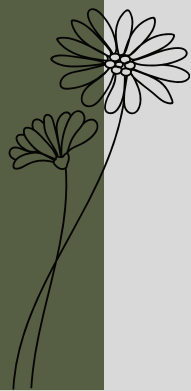

Q: What is special about the Killyon Manor estate?

A: Killyon Manor estate is a re-wilding nature reserve supported by the National Parks of Ireland. The estate emphasizes conservation and natural beauty. Guidelines must be followed by all guests to help preserve the natural environment.

After the ceremony

Q: Where can we take photographs

A: You are free to take photographs in and around the chapel and woodland. Access to the wider manor grounds and the manor is by special arrangement. Please stick to the paths, do not climb fences, open gates, or enter any other ruins except the chapel. See our map for good photo spots.
